



Do you need to add liquid to lead-acid batteries



Overview

As stated earlier, under normal circumstances, the battery will never lose sulfuric acid but will only lose water. That means the levels of sulfuric acid either free or in the plates remain the same. Though we have said under no circumstances should you add acid to the battery, there are some exceptions when you can add acid to the battery.
