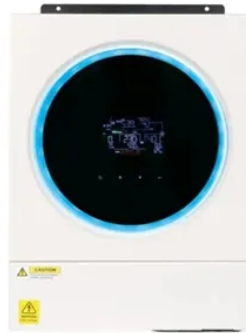




Unboxing Solar Panels in Developing Countries
